



## Behaviour Policy

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### Code of Conduct

Whilst attending Amersham Film School, we expect students to:

- Use socially acceptable behaviour
- Comply with the camp rules
- Respect one another, accepting differences of race, gender, ability, age and religion
- Develop their independence by maintaining self-discipline
- Ask for help if needed
- Enjoy their time at the camp or club.

It is inevitable that as children develop and learn, there are times when they need support and guidance to understand that their behaviour is not acceptable. Staff will try to determine the cause or triggers of the inappropriate behaviour to prevent the situation from recurring. However, inappropriate behaviour cannot be tolerated if it puts other students or staff at risk of harm or takes supervision away from other students.

Bullying in any form is inexcusable and will not be tolerated. Each student is expected to treat all other students with respect, and to help each other achieve the best possible experience.

Examples of unacceptable behaviour include:

- Refusing to follow behaviour guidelines or camp rules.
- Using profanity, vulgarity or obscenity.
- Stealing or damaging property (personal or camp property).
- Refusal to participate in activities or cooperate with staff.
- Disrupting a class.
- Leaving the classroom without permission.
- Endangering the health and safety of students and/or staff.
- Use of illicit drugs, alcohol or tobacco or sexual conduct of any kind.
- Teasing, making fun or bullying of other students or staff.
- Hitting or fighting of any kind.
